Proposed criteria and process for committee selection

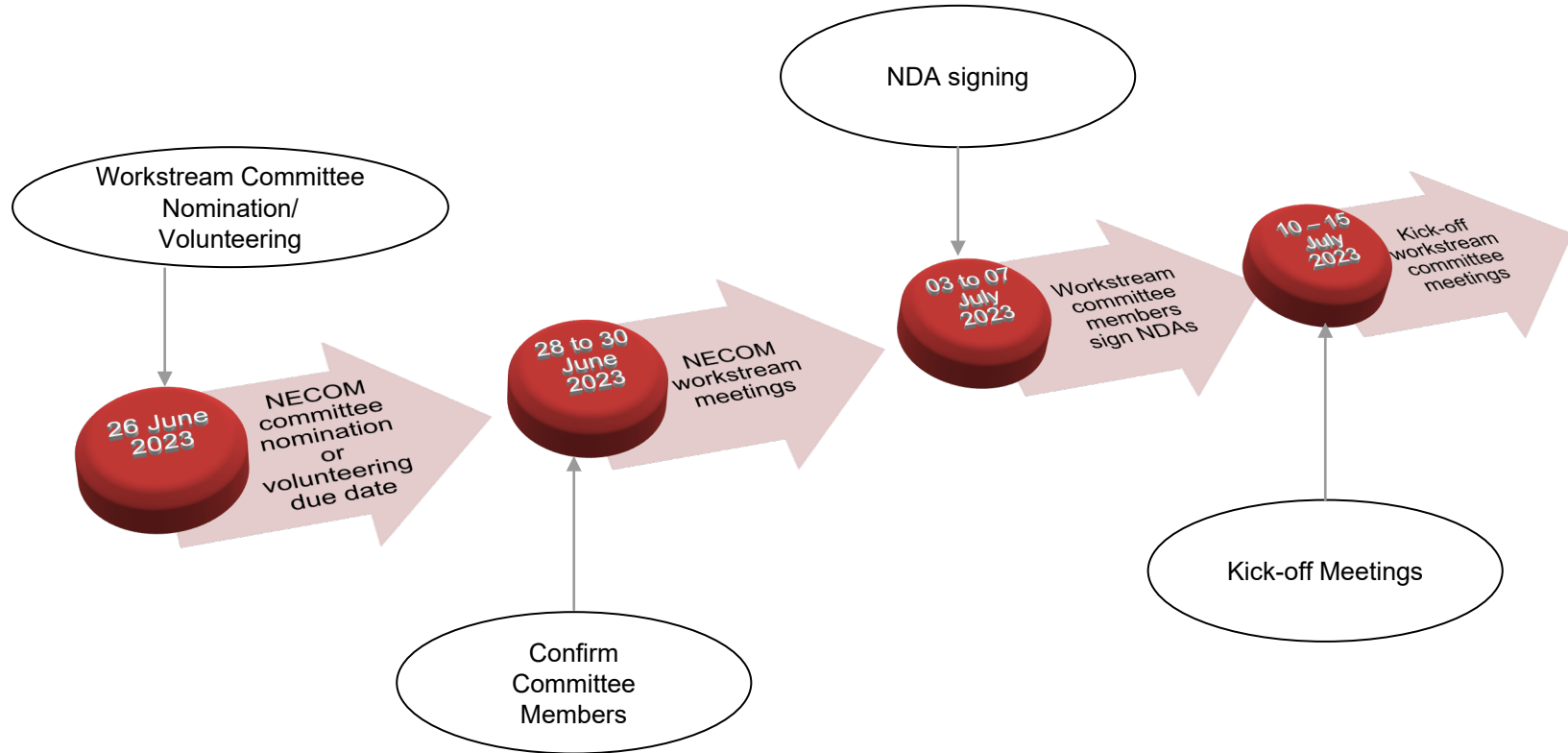
Workstream Committee members should:

- Have relevant skills and experience
- Have relative availability on a weekly basis (estimated 4 to 6 hours per week)
- Be willing to sign NDAs and conflict of interest declarations
- Must represent a business entity or organisation with interest in the energy sector

Next steps following the information sessions:

- Persons expressing interest in a workstream will be notified as a technical interest group
- A proposed committee of 4-6 people will be proposed based on experience and availability
- A 30min meeting of the broader workstream technical interest group will be called to confirm
- The elected business team will be start engaging on NECOM meetings, the technical interest group will be kept informed and updated. Should a committee member withdraw a replacement will be requested from the interest group.
